**Discuss 2021 Governing Body Short, Near and Long-Term Goals**

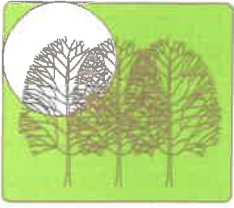
