Re: Work Session – RE: Presentation of Brand Identity Design – Willoughby Design

Willoughby Design, a local brand design agency, and O'Neill Events & Marketing were engaged to explore a brand identity evolution that will coincide with the City's 75th Anniversary celebration in 2023.

The team has taken a deep dive into understanding our city values, attributes, demographics and vision for the future. This learning process was the foundation for a recommended brand evolution created to both honor the City's past, and be representative of the forward-looking City that Leawood is today.

The Willoughby team will be taking us through the strategic process that the appointed task force has been meeting and working on over the last four months. As a reminder, the task force was comprised of Arts Council Chair Anne Blessing, Leawood Foundation Chair and Historic Commission member Alice Hawk, BZA Chair Bill Clawson, Planning Commission Chair Marc Elkins, Mayor Dunn as well as staff members Holly York and Chris Claxton, with the addition of City Clerk Stephen Powell following Ms. York's resignation

On September 6th, Willoughby will present the task force's recommended "new" visual identity including an evolved logo, colors, typography and sample applications for discussion.
